WHAT DOES A TRUSTEE DO?

The Board of Trustees of the North Greenbush Library District is actively seeking a new library trustee to restore the Board to a full membership of 11 trustees. According to the Handbook for Library Trustees of New York State, the responsibilities of trustees are few in number but broad in scope. They include:

- Create and develop the mission of the library;
- Regularly plan and evaluate the library's service programs;
- Secure adequate funding for the library's service program; f
- Evaluate the job performance of the Library Director;
- Exercise fiduciary responsibility for the use of public and private funds;
- Adopt policies and rules regarding the operation of the library;
- Maintain a Library that strives to meet the needs of the community;
- Promote the library to the local community;
- Conduct the business of the library in an open and ethical manner.

Fulfilling these responsibilities is a huge challenge and the current Board is looking for a North Greenbush resident willing to become a trustee and help the North Greenbush Library to become a more interactive member of the Town Community.
