

How to Obtain an Absentee Ballot for North Greenbush Public Library 2025 Budget Vote Held on September 12, 2024.

Only residents of the Town of North Greenbush otherwise qualified to vote in a general town election shall be qualified to vote in this election.

1. If you would like an absentee ballot, please call the library at 518-283-0303 or stop in to pick one up at the circulation desk. Library staff can also place the absentee ballot in an envelope with your name on it on the table in our vestibule.
2. Ballots will be available beginning Thursday, August 29, 2024. The library is open Monday through Friday from 10 AM to 7 PM and Saturdays between 10 AM and 2 PM.
3. Please read the instructions included with the Absentee Ballot Application carefully to ensure your completed ballot is eligible to be counted.
4. If you are requesting an Absentee Ballot due to COVID-19, please select “Temporary illness or physical disability” in Section 1 on the Absentee Ballot application. For Section 2 in the Absentee Ballot Application, please check the box for Special Election only; for Sections 5 and 6, the North Greenbush Public Library is the substitute for the board of elections. Please sign in Section 8 or your vote will not be counted!
5. Completed Absentee Ballot and the application should be placed in the provided envelope and sealed. The envelope may be dropped into the locked ballot box the library vestibule or given to or mailed to*:
